His main publications include Study of the Modern Military Legislation, Peace without Military Power, Frank Opinions on Contemporary World Affairs, Diagnose the revision of the constitution argument, The Hiroshima and Peace Constitution, 4th., Okinawa and Constitution, and Securing and Regenerating the Peace Constitution.
